Denaedin Snug Cabled Fingerless Gloves Written by Nancy, writer of the blog Getting Purly With It www.gettingpurlywithit.wordpress.com



Materials

Yarn: Artyarn beaded silk, Misti Alpaca dk, Debbie bliss pure silk, Debbie Bliss Alpaca/silk dk. Any dk yarn will do as long as you have about 100 yard of yarn. Sportsweight will do too but the glove will be a tiny bit bigger.

Needle Size 5 or size to obtain gauge! I am a very tight knitter so you might want to consider a different needle size!

Darning needle for seaming

Gauge:

6 st and 8 rows in = 1" in St st

Be sure to check your gauge, okay? It is not a disaster if you have 6st and 7 rows....it is only a fingerless glove...

Size: Length: approx. 6"

Width (when not seamed): approx. 5"

Directions

Step 1:

Cast on 40 sts. Make sure you have about 15" tail (for the seaming later on)

Start with 6 rows of k1, p1 ribbing.

STEP 2:

Now the Cable fun can begin!

LEFT HAND GLOVE

- 1) (RS) k7, p2, k1, p2, k6, p2, k1, p2, k17
- 2) (WS) p17, k2, p1, k2, p6, k2, p1, k2, p7 (or in other words knit the knits and purl the purls)
- 3) Repeat row 1
- 4) Repeat row 2
- 5) K7, p2, k1, p2, sl 3 st on cable needle and hold in front, k3 and k3 from cable needle, p2, k1, p2, k17
- 6) Knit the knits and purl the purls
- 7) Repeat row 1
- 8) Repeat row 2
- 9) Repeat row 1
- 10) Repeat row 2

Repeat row 5 to 10 form the pattern. Repeat these rows 6 more times, however in your very last repeat, omit row 9) and 10). In the end, you should have 7 cables in your glove.

STEP 3:

Almost there ©

Start 4 row k1, p1 ribbing and bind off in ribbing pattern. Bind off loosely!

Bind of loosely or with 1 size bigger needle. Make sure you leave a 8 to 10" tail when you cut off the yarn (this is for the seaming part).

STEP 4:

Seam that glove!

The base of your glove are the first 6 ribbed rows, the top of your glove are the 4 ribbed rows.

Start seaming down from the top for about 1 3/4 inches. Weave in the ends. Now with the tail end at the bottom of the glove, start seaming up for about 4 inches. Weave in ends.

If all went well, you should have an opening for your thumb that is about 1 1/4 inches wide.

It is all up to you where and how big exactly you want that thumb opening to be.

Now start on your Right Hand Glove! Step 1, 3 and 4 remain the same, step 2 you do as follows:

- 1) (RS) k17, p2, k1, p2, k6, p2, k1, p2, k7
- 2) (WS) p7, k2, p1, k2, p6, k2, p1, k2, p17 (or in other words knit the knits and purl the purls)
- 3) Repeat row 1
- 4) Repeat row 2
- 5) K17, p2, k1, p2, sl 3 st on cable needle and hold in front, k3 and k3 from cable needle, p2, k1, p2, k7
- 6) Knit the knits and purl the purls
- 7) Repeat row 1
- 8) Repeat row 2
- 9) Repeat row 1
- 10) Repeat row 2

Row 5 to 10 form the pattern. Repeat 6 more times, however in your very last repeat, omit row 9) and 10).

Continue with step 3 and 4. Enjoy!
